



Things to remember about the word “Dinosaur” not showing up in the Bible:

1. The Bible was translated into English in 1611.
2. The word DINOSAUR was not invented until 1841.
3. Since the word dinosaur was not invented until 230 years after the KJV of the Bible was translated it won't show up in the Bible.
4. The word DRAGON was the word that was used up until 1841 to describe dinosaur like creatures.

Things to remember about Dinosaurs in the Ark:

1. All the below verses which mention the 5 key words (*tannîyn, drākōn, bahāmôt, livyātān, šārāp 'ûp šārāp*) that refer to dinosaurs/dragons take place AFTER the flood except the first Bible verse in *Genesis 1:21.

Something to remember about the above Bible verses: Context is key. If the translation you are reading translates the word “*tannîyn*” as jackal read the surrounding verses and see if dragon/dinosaur better applies.
