



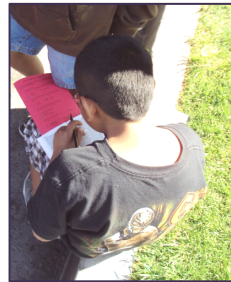
Open Air Campaigners (OAC)

OAC is an international and interdenominational Christian mission which has roots back to **1892** in Australia, where it began taking the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ to people of all ages in the public arena.

Now based in **27 countries**, our Evangelist-Missionaries go wherever non-Christians can be reached effectively with the Gospel. City-center, open-air meetings are an important part of the work in many countries, but we also regularly share in schools, at fairs, at beaches, in factories, hospitals, and retirement homes.

In the United States (US), we currently have branches in **15 cities** and we are praying and looking to the Lord to add even more branches. Please join us in praying this. By His grace, the Southern-California Branch shares the Gospel annually with about **5,000 souls** and we witness **many publicly profess Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior!**

OAC has pioneered a number of visual techniques for presenting the Gospel, most notably the sketch board. Our evangelists also use a variety of object lessons and even ventriloquism to keep the attention of audiences of all ages. Our manner and methods of presentation aim to attract and hold a crowd, allowing them the greatest possible opportunity to understand and respond to the Good News of Christ.



We also **train Christians** to communicate their most-holy faith more effectively (Ephesians 4:11-13). We give regular courses at Bible colleges around the world, as well as in local churches with whom we work closely.
